#### Community Concerns Re: Metrolinx Train Noise & Noise Walls

Many residents have expressed concerns regarding the noise of diesel engines, bells and brakes along the Stouffville Corridor in Agincourt especially with the Metrolinx plan for diesel trains to run every seven minutes along the double track. As a result, AVCA Executive asked Metrolinx to test the mitigation factor of the noise walls which have been installed. AVCA has not yet received the data from the testing. Subsequently AVCA has met with Associate Minister of Transportation Kinga Surma and MPP Aris Babikian on Thursday, August 27, 2020. AVCA will forward the noise mitigation results as we receive them.
