Scarborough Subway – McCowan Station



Sheppard Subway – McCowan to Don Mills

AVCA wishes to clarify that the Scarborough Subway does not continue along Sheppard Avenue from McCowan to Don Mills. At present the Sheppard Subway is only a dotted line on the Metrolinx map and is not funded.
