Stouffville Corridor GO Train Concerns

AVCA appreciates the many residents who are vocal in their concerns regarding use of the Stouffville Corridor trains – a public transit asset for Agincourt residents if the trains run! Since August 18, 2023 trains on the Stouffville Corridor now run on weekdays southbound between 6:00 am until 4:00 pm and northbound between 9:12 am until 7:12 pm. There are now trains on the weekend! Please check the Agincourt Station GO Schedule for exact train times!

For many who rent or have bought in our community and who do not work the 9:00 am -5:00 pm hours, who do not own cars, who attend college or university, who need to reach late appointments or who want to enjoy a sports game, concert or show downtown - this is a tremendous inconvenience with NO EVENING TRAINS. AVCA has advocated tirelessly for improved service. You are encouraged to address your concerns regarding train reduction to torontoeast@metrolinx.com.

AVCA in the Media re: Metrolinx

Our concerns are ongoing. Our community received noise walls that are inadequate in mitigating train noise, reflective and lower than specifications that were provided for noise walls. Our community was the first in the GO RER Expansion that began on the Stouffville Corridor in 2017. Our noise walls are not at the 2022 Metrolinx standard other Ontarians are enjoying. This inadequacy impacts negatively those living along the rail. As a result, AVCA Executive has held many meetings with MPP Babikian and has forwarded a letter to Metrolinx CEO Phil Verster. AVCA is awaiting a meeting with the Minister of Transportation scheduled to happen in October 2023. Attached is our AVCA letter which was sent to the Minister of Transportation Prabmeet Sarkaria.

Lack of evening trains results in 1.5 hour TTC rides after 7:12 pm. The Tax Funded New Agincourt GO Station is only accessible for washrooms, seating or in-person assistance between 6:00 am – 11:45 am. Loud GO Station announcements are impacting commuters on the platform as well as those who live along the tracks. Within AVCA boundaries grade separations for our safety are essential on Finch Avenue and Huntingwood Avenue as well as the proposed closure of Havendale Road. AVCA Executive is working with Metrolinx to have historical photos displayed within the new station, mirrors installed at each of the stairways into the pedestrian tunnels, continued maintenance of the landscaping and improved lighting in the pathways to the station on the north end. City Zoning Changes & Development

Throughout Toronto Multi-Tenant Houses, Laneway Suites, Multiplexes and Garden Suites can be built on properties formerly zoned for single family homes:

The Expanding Housing Options in Neighbourhoods (EHON) Major Streets Proposal Study sets out a proposal for Official Plan and Zoning By-law Amendments to permit townhouses and small-scale apartment buildings on major streets in neighbourhoods across the city. Consultations from the public are planned. There are 6 consultation events planned between October 12 and 25, 2023. **In-person consultation events:** Oct 12: 4:30 - 7:00pm, Scarborough Civic Centre. **Toronto-wide Virtual Events:** Two webinars are proposed to be held on October 25, 2023: 2:30 - 4:30pm or 6:00 - 8:00pm. Housing & The Delta Shelter

Many residents have inquired about the decommissioning of The Delta. At present AVCA has been informed that the contract for use of the hotel as a shelter is finished in August 2024. AVCA Executive continually dialogue with Councilor Mantas, MPP Aris Babikian and MP Yip regarding the critical need for supportive and affordable housing in Toronto. At monthly Community Liaison Committee meetings advocates for alternative housing for the Delta clients and the return of The Delta for use by Scarborough residents.
