On March 9, 2018 Rhoda Potter President AVCA and Randy MacDougall Vice President AVCA engaged in a "Walk About" of Agincourt GO station, Marilyn/Lockie Pathway, Havendale Road and Huntingwood Avenue with CEO Phil Verster. The following meeting included CEO Phil Verster, MP Jean Yip, MPP Soo Wong, Councillor Chin Lee, Councillor Karygiannis, Principal Mira Nam-Wong and Vice Principal Jason Smit of Agincourt Collegiate Institute as well as other Metrolinx employees. Our discussion focused on safety at track crossings, traffic congestion, noise mitigation, overflow parking at Agincourt GO station and tree replacements. We posed the question of when the next train increase would take place, however we do not have an answer for you as yet. We have continued to be clear that we endorse train increases however we have concerns about the impact on our community.
